

St John's Trust Company (PVT) Limited (SJTC) v Medlands (PTC) Limited & Ors [2021] CA (Bda) 20 Civ

The Bermuda Court of Appeal has recently handed down its reasons for dismissing the appeal in *St John's Trust Company (PVT) Limited (SJTC) v Medlands (PTC) Limited* [2021] CA (Bda) 20 Civ. John Machell QC and Dan McCourt Fritz instructed by Kennedys acted for the protector who took the lead in successfully resisting the appeal of SJTC against various first instance orders made by Subair-Williams J including its removal as de facto or de jure trustee. The judgment, given by Smellie JA, contains some useful comment on the Court's supervisory jurisdiction over trusts, the focus on the interests of the beneficiaries and the appropriateness of a trustee pursuing an appeal against the wishes of the human beneficiaries.
