In addition, he has, along with Dr Sarah McKibbin, of the University of Southern Queensland, edited a collection of papers looking at the common law jurisprudence of the conflict of laws. Anthony also edits the International Private Law section of the Lloyd's International Maritime and Commercial Law Yearbook.
